



“Talking It Out”

Our “Talking It Out” discussion sheet is intended to help get conversation started and make connection a bit easier. Feel free to discuss each question, but it could be that choosing a couple questions you resonate with most is all it takes to step into community.

1. John 13 tells the story of Jesus serving His disciples’ by washing their feet. When John wrote about the experience, he said Jesus knew God loved Him. So, He served. *Unpack this: What does this statement mean? What must John have observed and experienced in Jesus that moved him to make this statement? How does this speak to you?*
2. Having a Servant Heart means looking for the need, reading the room to see where I’m needed, and then fulfilling that. *On a 1 to 5 scale where 1=not at all and 5=totally me, how would you rate the way you do this? Share what this is like for you.*
3. Being served communicates that I believe you’re needed as much as I am. You are relevant in this family. Having a Servant Heart not only means serving, it also means we need to find ways to need each other. *What do you feel/think when someone says, “How can I help?” Unpack that.*
4. Today’s challenge:
 - (1) Call one person you haven’t seen or talked to in a while and ask, “How can I help?”
 - (2) To whom can you say, “Can you help me with _____?”

What makes this challenge a challenge for you? Will you take the challenge?
5. Take time to pray for each other.
